This entry-point experience at three library branches introduced skills of listening that dignify and humanize both speakers and listeners, and heal relationships and create community.

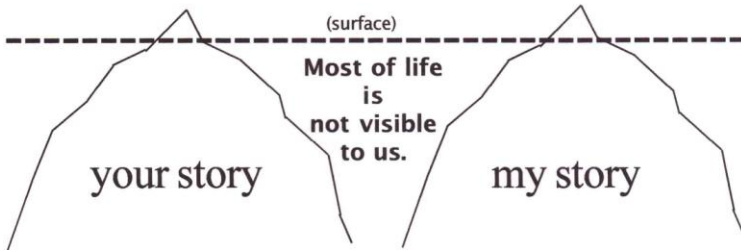

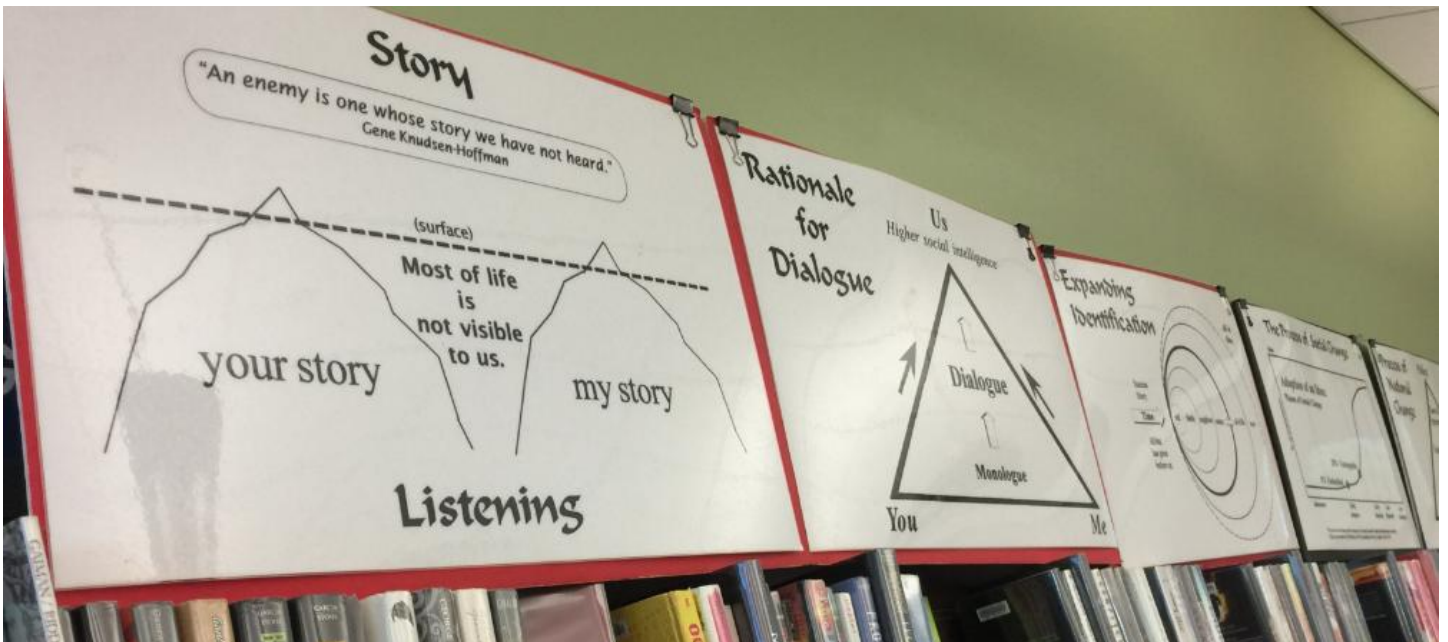

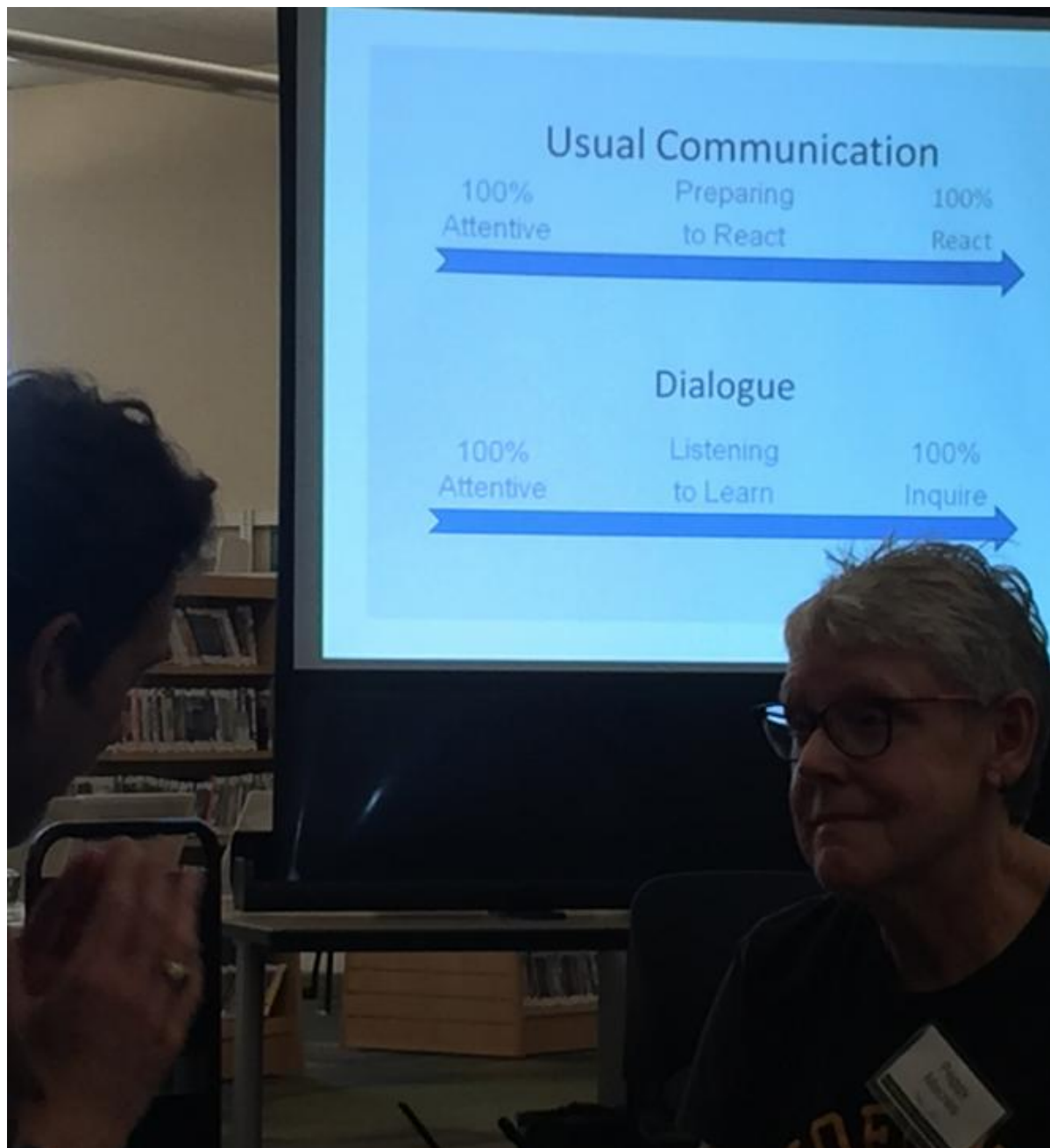
